Only shooters will be considered for Shooting Costume awards. Shooting Cowgirl and Shooting Cowboy will be judged on outfits worn by shooters during the match on Saturday.

### Evening Costume Awards

Everyone attending the event is encouraged to participate in the evening costume contest – shooters, spouse, family, vendors, and volunteers.

Evening Costume Categories will include: Ladies, Gentlemen, Couples, Dancehall Darling, Military, Junior Boy, Junior Girl



Judging will occur informally from 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. in the main Clubhouse during the Promenade.

All costume awards will be presented after dinner on Saturday night. Award certificates will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.



Costumes will be judged:

- ❑ 40% on authenticity (appropriate to the era 1860 – 1898)
- ❑ 30% on originality, and
- ❑ 30% on detail depending upon category.
