Hints and Tips for Intermediate Shooters – Shave Seconds Off Your Time

"Shootin' good and Ready to do Better"

This clinic is aimed at intermediate shooters who are shooting well but wish to improve their performance by shaving a few seconds per stage. We will discuss equipment, different practice techniques, and mental concentration and focus. One on one instruction will be given on drawing and holstering, transitions, different shotgun techniques, and economy of motion.

We will be doing live fire practice and shooting a demo stage at least once each.

Participants will require approx. 100 rifle and revolver rounds and 30-40 shotgun rounds.

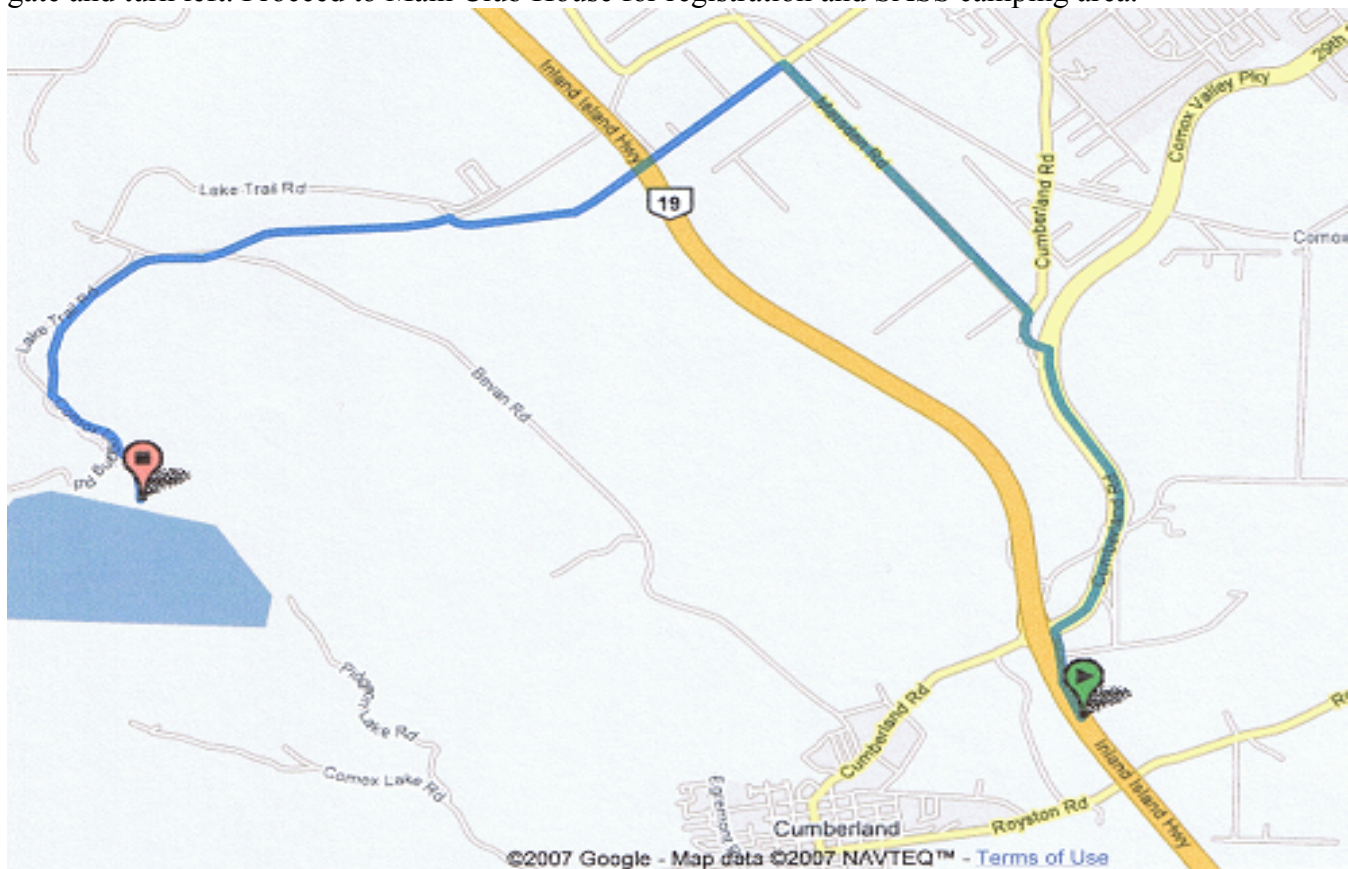

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE

From Hwy 19, head northwest on Exit 117 toward Cumberland Rd .7 km, Turn right at Cumberland Rd 2.2 km, Turn left to stay on Cumberland Rd .3 km, Turn left at Marsden Rd 2.3 km, Turn left at Lake Trail Rd 2.5 km, Turn left at Comox Main Logging Rd 1.5 km, Continue on Comox Logging Rd to range entrance gate and turn left. Proceed to Main Club House for registration and SASS camping area.
